


Course		Number of students	Description
General English		max. 12 	Classes focus on spoken communication and language accuracy while expanding grammar and vocabulary knowledge.
Exam Preparation IELTS, FCE and CAE		max. 12 	Learn the grammar and vocabulary you will need for the exam, common errors and strategies to help you get the best mark.
English Outside the Classroom		max. 12 	Enjoy the sights of Edinburgh while continuing to practise and improve your English. Minimum B1 level. (3 rd July – 25 th August only).
Specialised Small Group Lessons	Business English	max. 4 	Focussed on professional language (e.g. writing emails and giving presentations) and adapted to individual student needs.
	Exam Preparation IELTS, CAE and FCE	max. 4 	Exam practice aimed at the weaknesses of individual students. Writing and speaking are usually the focus of the class.
	General English	max. 4 	Intensive speaking, pronunciation and writing practice. Classes are adapted to the needs of the individual students in the class.






